"We wanted a house that was non-traditional and non-linear (not rectangular or square). We installed an elevator for comfort and convenience. It is designed for any individuality, like catering for someone in a wheelchair. The living areas, bedrooms, kitchen, pool, braai area, bar lounge area are all on the same level with no stairs. That is what our design set out to achieve."
