

The perfect location for these residents' perfect home, this property is filled with spaces that are rich in character and charm. Situated within a game reserve, the interaction between inside and outside was pivotal in the design. To get the most from the location, the exterior was designed to be as minimalist as possible, and this now allows for some dramatic forms rising from the bushes and surrounding trees. The design has also resulted in four main structures with prominent roof forms linked with glazed passages and ramps.


In keeping with its ability to exist seamlessly with its surroundings and without causing too much strain on the grid and other utilities, the home is also completely off the grid. It is fitted with a borehole, water purification system and a PV solar system.

Apart from its architectural appeal, the home's interiors are striking in treatment and aesthetic. The colour palette for the inside spaces is derived directly from the landscape outside – think shades of sand, leather, copper, wood and subdued green vegetation. They all come together to present warm, welcoming and stylish spaces. Although many of these colours are muted, the contrasting black feature walls exude luxury and amplify the home's beauty. >

Many other elements have come together within the home to make it stand out, including the fireplace fitted into a column made from copper in the open-plan dining/kitchen area, the copper statement lights above the dining table and the stunning chandelier in the lounge area. There is also the quite interesting guest WC. Here, a rose gold tap comes from the concrete ceiling and flows into a slanted 3.8m-long custom-made steel basin, allowing a true experience when washing your hands.

Also worthy of note is the wooden ramp floor, made from 80-year-old reclaimed wood from the owners' hometown in the North West province. Like the ramp, the home itself tells a story that warms the heart and fills the soul. ■
